Fundraising campaign takes to the battlefields

Staff and volunteers of Victim Support Warwickshire donned their walking gear for a sponsored Battlefields Walk on 8th May. The choice of Battlefields was appropriate, since the day was also marked by celebrations of 60 years since VE Day. In the end, the walkers completed a circuit of the battlefield sites at Naseby, Bosworth and Edge Hill – around 18 miles in total.

Gillian Nussey MBE, fundraiser for VSW says,

“We are the champions for victims in the community and are determined that their needs should be met. Most of the support offered is provided by volunteers, who need to receive initial training – and that costs money. Where volunteers are supporting victims and witnesses of serious crimes, or vulnerable witnesses, that training needs to be specialised.”
