BURGLARY DWELLING

Between 2130 hours 25th June 06 and 0630 hours 26th June 06 unknown offender/s have attempted to gain entry to a dwelling in High Street, Welford on Avon by breaking a window at the rear of the property with a lump of concrete. No entry was gained, nothing stolen.

Incident number 257 of 26th June 06 refers.

Sometime prior to 13th July 06 unknown offender/s have attempted to gain entry to a dwelling on The Fordway, Lower Quinton by using a jemmy type instrument to force open the rear doors. No entry was gained, nothing stolen.

AUTOCRIME

Between 1830 hours on 28th June 06 and 0640 hours on 29th June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a secure and unattended BMW X5 parked in St Lawrence Way, Bidford on Avon. They have smashed the tailgate window to gain entry to the vehicle, once

inside they have then stolen a lap top computer case (empty). This was later recovered on the Green.

Incident number 74 of 29th June 06 refers.

Between 2200 hours 28th June 06 and 0900 hours 29th June 06 unknown offender/s have approached a secure and unattended Mitsubishi Lancer estate parked in St Lawrence Way, Bidford. They have then smashed the rear windscreen to gain entry to the vehicle, once inside they have then stolen a black bag containing three Sennheiser Radio microphones from within the boot. The parcel shelf had covered this.

Incident number 133 of 29th June 06 refers.

At approximately 0300 hours on 3rd July 06 unknown offender/s have approached a premises on Campden Road, Lower Quinton, they have then forced the front near side quarter light window to a VW Camper van enabling them to reach inside and open the door. Once inside they have then stolen a Kenwood stereo and speakers from within. They have then approached a Land Rover parked at the same location and have force the front near side door lock to gain entry. Once inside they have then removed the internal light and stolen a Sony CD player and speakers from within.

THEFT

During the evening of 29th June 06 two unknown offenders have approached two teenage males on the 'big meadow' at Bidford. They asked for the time and when one of the lads looked at his mobile phone one of the offenders took it.

One of the offenders is described as: White male, black hair, moustache, 6'1" tall, early 20's, wearing no T-shirt.
