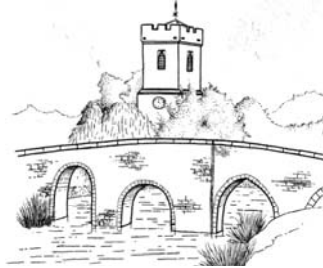


# **BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL**

## **In the County of Warwickshire**



This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud. Week to 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2008



### **BURGLARY DWELLING**

Overnight between 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a property on Wessons Road, Bidford on Avon. They have then gained entry to an integral garage and removed power tools from within.  
Incident 205 of 13<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.

Prior to 14<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a block of garages on The Leys, Bidford on Avon. They have then gained entry to one of the garages and moved items about inside.  
Incident 134 of 14<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.



### **BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING**

Between 1200 hours on 19<sup>th</sup> January and 0800 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a new build property on Goose Lane, Lower Quinton. They then pulled fencing apart and attempted to force the lock on a steel container. Between 1630 hours on 21<sup>st</sup> January and 0800 hours on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 08 offender/s approached same property and sprayed grafitti on a steel container.  
Incident 256 of 22<sup>nd</sup> January 08 refers.

Overnight between 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a property on Georges Elm Lane, Bidford. They have then gained entry to a shed.  
Incident 421 of 21<sup>st</sup> January 08 refers.



## **AUTOCRIME**

Between 1900 hours and 2000 hours on 19<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s have stolen a green BMW from High Street, Bidford.  
Incident 551 of 19<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.



## **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

Prior to 0600 hours on 18<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Church Street, Bidford and smashed the rear windscreen.  
Incident 78 of 18<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.



## **THEFT**

Between 0900 hours and 1530 hours on 10<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Quineys Leys, Welford on Avon and removed the rear registration plate.  
Incident 105 of 11<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.

Overnight between 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a blue Audi on Millfield Close, Lower Quinton and smashed the rear windscreen.  
Incident 69 of 15<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.

Overnight between 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a Vauxhall Vectra on Millfield Close, Lower Quinton. They have then smashed the rear windscreen and removed a briefcase from within.  
Incident 72 of 15<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.

Between 1700 hours on 18<sup>th</sup> January and 1015 hours on 19<sup>th</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Perkins Close, Salford Priors. They then gained entry and removed 2 Sony speakers from within.  
Incident 258 of 19<sup>th</sup> January 08 refers.

Between 2100 hours on 18<sup>th</sup> January and 1500 hours on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Pear Tree Close, Long Marston. They then forced the front lock and removed a Stihl saw and Bosch drill.  
Incident 329 of 22<sup>nd</sup> January 08 refers.

Between 1700 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> January and 0940 hours on 21<sup>st</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a Ford Transit in Long Marston. They have then gained entry and stolen tools from within.  
Incident 211 of 21<sup>st</sup> January 08 refers.

Between 1800 hours on 21<sup>st</sup> January and 0630 hours on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 08 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Falcoln Crescent, Bidford. They have then forced the rear doors and removed tools from within.

Incident 103 of 22<sup>nd</sup> January 08 refers.

The definition of anti-social behaviour in Section 1 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – “behaviour which causes or is likely to cause harrassment, alarm or distress to one or more people who are not in the same household as the perpetrator”.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) can therefore cover a wide range of activities, from those that cause minor nuisance or irritation to major incidents of harrassment, threats or actual acts of violence.

Individual incidents of ASB may be dealt with by means of Warning Letters, ABCs and ASBOs.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an ‘incident number’ – you should be

given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are 'managed' and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.

 **CRIMESTOPPERS**

If you did have information regarding the displayed incidents, but for whatever reason do not wish to contact the police directly, then you can ring 0800 555 111 and give the information to the Crimestoppers Charity. Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
