

# **BIDFORD ON AVON PARISH COUNCIL**

## **In the County of Warwickshire**



This crime summary is a look at the crimes of public interest that occurred on the Bidford, Great Alne and Long Marston policing area over the last 14 days. We do not as normal practice include crimes of shoplifting, bilking, domestic violence or fraud.

### **BURGLARY DWELLING**

Prior to 1400 hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 09 two males have let themselves into a property on The Leys, Bidford-on-Avon and removed a handbag from a bedroom. One male is described as white, around 40 years of age, 6' tall, large build wearing a big brown hat and a khaki coloured jacket. The other male is described as white, medium build, late 20's, 6' tall, black hair, wearing black bomber jacket and black trousers.  
Incident 307 of 2<sup>nd</sup> March 09 refers.



### **BURGLARY COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDING**

Between 1730 hours on 1<sup>st</sup> March and 1420 hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached premises on Georges Elm Lane, Bidford-on-Avon. They have then removed tools and scrap copper cabling.  
Incident 350 of 2<sup>nd</sup> March 09 refers.

Prior to 8<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached a property on Ebsdorf Close, Bidford-on-Avon and forced open the garage door.  
Incident 228 of 8<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.





## **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

Between 0900 hours and 1630 hours on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached a property on Campden Road, Clifford Chambers. They have then caused damage to an electric gate and turned on an outside tap, causing local flooding to the area. Incident 379 of 3<sup>rd</sup> March 09 refers.

During the evening of 4<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s have approached vehicles on Bramley Way, Bidford-on-Avon and thrown fluid over the vehicles, causing the paintwork to flake. Incident 85 of 5<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.



## **THEFT**

Between 0900 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> February and 25<sup>th</sup> February 09 unknown offender/s approached premises on School Road, Salford Priors and removed a stainless steel conveyor belt from the car park. Incident 149 of 25<sup>th</sup> February 09 refers.

Between 27<sup>th</sup> February and 5<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached premises on Waterloo Road, Bidford-on-Avon. They have then approached vehicles and cut fuel pipes and siphoned fuel. Incident 368 of 5<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.

Between 0800 hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> March and 0800 hours on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s have approached a vehicle on Waterloo Road, Bidford-on-Avon and removed both front and rear number plates. Incident 223 of 3<sup>rd</sup> March 09 refers.

At approximately 0340 hours on 4<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Ebsdorf Close, Bidford-on-Avon. They have then smashed the rear window and removed a bag from underneath the seat. Incident 111 of 4<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.

At approximately 0550 hours on 4<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached a vehicle on Ebsdorf Close, Bidford-on-Avon. They have then forced entry and removed a large quantity of tools. Incident 96 of 4<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.

Between 2130 hours on 5<sup>th</sup> March and 0415 hours on 6<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached a stationery lorry on the dual carriageway between Evesham and Salford Priors. They have then removed diesel from the fuel tank and cut the side curtain. Incident 67 of 6<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.

Between 1900 hours and 2130 hours on 6<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s approached a van on High Street, Bidford-on-Avon and some ladders from the roof.  
Incident 593 of 6<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.

Prior to 10<sup>th</sup> March 09 unknown offender/s have removed a vehicle from the car park of a working mens' club in Clifford Chambers.  
Incident 160 of 10<sup>th</sup> March 09 refers.

### **ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR**

The definition of anti-social behaviour in Section 1 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – “behaviour which causes or is likely to cause harrassment, alarm or distress to one or more people who are not in the same household as the perpetrator”.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) can therefore cover a wide range of activities, from those that cause minor nuisance or irritation to major incidents of harrassment, threats or actual acts of violence.

Individual incidents of ASB may be dealt with by means of Warning Letters, ABCs and ASBOs.

All to note a Public Service Desk at Headquarters is now operational. The Public Service Desk (PSD) is designed to put Police Officers back in the control room, thus enabling a better service delivery to members of the public wishing to speak to a Police Officer on

any matter which does not necessarily need Police deployment. Anybody wishing to speak to the Police about any issue that does not require a Police Officer to attend can do so via this Desk. Contacting any of the Police station telephone numbers will direct you to the switchboard where you can then ask for the Public Service Desk.

We are often asked the best way to report an incident or to make contact with a Police officer. Should a member of the public witness or be affected by a crime whereby there is a threat of injury, injury or damage or theft of property and the incident is ongoing and offenders are still at the scene, they should ring 999, classed as an emergency or an immediate response incident.

Should the incident have already occurred and is not ongoing, for example waking up and find your car has been broken into, you should ring one of the normal Police station numbers and ask to report a crime or an incident. You will be put through to the force control room or the crime desk. Please ask for an 'incident number' – you should be given one. If a crime has been committed against you, you will be given a crime reference number by the crime desk or by the officer who attends the incident. Such incidents are 'managed' and you should be given an indication of when an officer can attend.

If you wish to speak to an officer about a non-urgent matter, please use the list of contacts, which are always included in our newsletters.

Hopefully the Public Help Desk will help members of the public when they wish to speak to the Police.

Crimestoppers will then pass the information to the Police without revealing any details of the caller. You may also receive a reward.
